



Machine operator's arm sucked into piece of equipment

\$1.5 million settlement

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A then-55-year-old machine operator was attempting to clean a roller when his left arm was pulled into an unguarded in-running nip point. He remained trapped for several minutes as the rollers continued to pull him further into the machine.

The machine was purchased from a used machine dealer that had not performed any risk assessment or hazard analysis and sold the machine to the employer.

The employer had also engaged the services of an outside engineering company to help set up and integrate the machine with a larger production line.

The plaintiffs alleged that the dealer failed to conduct any sort of safety analysis and sold the machine without guards or proper instruction, and that the engineering company failed to properly locate safety stop devices and allowed the machine to go into production with unguarded hazards.

The plaintiff employee suffered numerous orthopedic injuries to his left arm and shoulder, chest and ribs, and knee. He also developed post-traumatic stress disorder and anxiety.

The plaintiff's spouse made a loss of consortium claim because she had become more of a caretaker than a life partner to her husband in their golden years.

Plaintiffs' counsel were able to defeat summary judgment motions from both defendants and were able to resolve the case through mediation a few months before trial.
