



# Fall from defective scaffold results in brain injury

#### \$10 million settlement

A 20-year-old union laborer fell from a defective scaffold and suffered a traumatic brain injury when he landed on the ground 18 feet below.

With just six months in the union and as a construction worker overall, the plaintiff lacked training and supervision. The scaffold lacked any reasonably safe access point, requiring the plaintiff to attempt to climb up the side to reach the upper levels to perform his work.

Plaintiff's counsel were able to show that there had been numerous scaffold and fall protection safety violations committed by the plaintiff's employer during the course of the project leading up to the accident.

The defendant general contractor failed to enforce its own policies and contractual obligations for safety against the subcontractor. The evidence showed that the defendant failed to perform a single inspection of the subcontractor's work during the three weeks leading to the incident, despite the repeated violations.

The plaintiff's brain injury resulted in ongoing disability, including an inability to recognize his own liabilities on a consistent basis. As a young man with an infant daughter, the plaintiff was unable to provide the type of care and life for his child that he previously could as a well-compensated union laborer.
